

#### **DePaul Summer Enrichment Program:**

Students seeking an intensive English immersion experience may take classes in Academic English, while exploring the architectural legacy and ethnic communities of Chicago. Courses offer students the opportunity to practice listening and speaking skills, develop their presentation skills, discover their own national community's place in Chicago and much more.

#### Program details:

 Summer Enrichment Program consists of two short courses and students can participate in either session or both. The full program spans seven weeks (July 6 to August 21).

**Session I:** The Chicago Experience: Our Ethnic Communities (July 6 to July 28)

**Session II:** The Chicago Experience: Our Architectural Legacy (July 30 to August 21)

- Classes meet Monday through Friday from 10:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m., 15 class hours per week
- This is a non-credit, academic English program
- Program includes special excursions and field trips providing students the opportunity to apply their in-class learning as they experience the city of Chicago

#### **DePaul Academic Courses:**

(For students with English proficiency)

Students seeking academic credits may take courses from a wide range of disciplines including: business, computing and digital media, science and health, and liberal arts and social sciences. With over 500 courses to choose from, students can create a summer program to meet their individual needs.

#### Program details:

- Academic Courses have flexible start dates for five week sessions (June 15, June 30, July 21)
- Students take up to two courses per five week session and can earn up to nine credits\* to transfer back to their home institution.
  \*DePaul University's academic calendar is based on the quarter system.
  4.5 quarter hours = 3 semester hours. It is the students' responsibility to confirm the transferability of credits with their home institution.
- Summer 2015 courses will be viewable online in late January, registration begins mid-February

- Customized packages available for cohorts of eight or more students which may include: airport pickup, transit pass, special programming, field trips, and room and board
